She is also chairperson of the Board of Trustees for the Tenth Circuit Historical Society and a member of the Utah Women's Forum. She is a past president of the David K. Watkiss-Sutherland II Inn of Court, the Utah Chapter of the Federal Bar Association and the Utah State Bar's Antitrust & Unfair Competition Section.
